Fee Payment

Fee invoices will be emailed each Semester (twice a year). Fees can be paid as follows:

1. Up Front Yearly Tuition by **3 March 2017** with a 3% discount
2. Per Semester as listed below

Other important fee information

Activity Fees

Activity fees are charged separately from the tuition fee and cover costs for camps, excursions, external College sports and carnivals. Fees for year 5 – year 8 include equipment packs. There are no discounts on activity fees.

Building Fund , Library Donations and Scholarship

This is optional and not a part of the normal education expenses but an important aspect of the development of the College. Suggested donations will appear on each account with donations of \$2.00 or more being tax deductible.

Senior School Subject Elective Fees

Elective subject fees apply to specific costs associated with the senior student elective. Please refer to the Subject Elective Fee sheet.

Senior School External Course Fees

Costs associated with external courses are to be paid by parents. A rebate of 16.5% will be deducted from College fees in addition to any government assistance obtained.

Enrolment Deposit

An Enrolment Deposit of \$500 per family is required on acceptance of enrolment. This is payable prior to your child starting at the College. The Enrolment Deposit will be refunded to you when your last child leaves the College or deducted from your account where College fees are still outstanding.

Overdue Account

Reminder notices for outstanding payment of accounts. The full outstanding amount should be paid within 14 days from receipt of a reminder notice. If full payment is not possible within 14 days, alternative payment arrangements suitable to the College should be made with the Business Manager. Bursary Guidelines and Application Forms are available from the College office for fee relief.

Working Bee Levy

The first fee invoice will include a Working Bee Levy of \$100. A minimum of 8hrs volunteer work is required for your Levy to be refunded. Completed volunteer hours need to be recorded on sign in at the College Administration Reception or at the Saturday Working Bees (twice a year). Contributed hours will be deducted from your fee invoice.

Textbook Levies

Charlton parents are not required to purchase text books for students in Years 7 – 10. Text books are given to students at the beginning of the year and students are responsible for returning these at the end of the year. Lost or damaged text books will incur a fee. Students studying in Years 11 and 12 are required to purchase text books for their relevant subjects. A list of books and equipment required will be issued to students at the beginning of the year from their respective teachers.

Deregistering

Students deregistering from Charlton are required to give a terms notice in writing to the Principal. Failure to give sufficient notice will incur a penalty of one term's fees. Please refer to the Parent Handbook for more information.
